This handy checklist will help keep you on track during the wedding planning process, and guide you through what to do when.

First things first	Confirm the Registrar / Church is available on your preferred date
Insure your engagement ring!	
Discuss with each other the type of wedding you both want What's important to you both and your must haves you're both on the same page before you start planning	Confirm your wedding venue Review & sign contract (make sure to check what is included in the venue hire, don't assume that because you see something in the venue it is included as part of the venue hire), pay deposit.
Set your wedding budget Establish your top priorities and areas where you want to save/splurge. Set up up a spreadsheet to track spending	Set up a wedding website
Gather inspiration Explore Pinterest and start pinning wedding inspiration, keeping expectations realistic	11 months to go
Recping expectations reunside	Research and shortlist suppliers Gather information on services and costs for all the suppliers you'll need.
12 months to go	Choose and book your key suppliers Caterer (if not provided as part of your venue) / photographer / videographer / florist
Draft your initial guest list This will give you an estimate of guest numbers, which are key for your budget, venue and catering. Decide on ceremony type, define wedding style and wedding vision	Research wedding dresses and boutiques and start dress shopping Most dress boutiques need 6 months to order your dres in for your first fitting.
Civil, religious, celebrant ceremony; country house	Give notice / register your intention to marry
wedding, marquee wedding as examples. Hire a professional Wedding Planner	Choose your bridesmaids / best man / others you want to include in the bridal party
Decide on your preferred wedding date and location Think about your favourite season / location / time of year you want to get married.	
Invest in wedding insurance	
Research venues and visit your favourites Visit your shortlisted venues before you decide on your final choice. Some venues do book up 12 - 18 months in	

advance, so be sure to tick this off your list early.

Order on the day stationery Set up your wedding gift list / registry Book your honeymoon Choose and book cake designer, order cake samples, order your wedding cake 1 month to go Choose and order your wedding invitations Confirm your suppliers and venue/s, doublecheck timings Final dress fitting with your accessories Reconfirm final numbers and dietary 8 months to go requirements with your caterer Reserve accommodation for you and your Finalise table plan and organise place cards guests Settle final balances with your suppliers and Choose the readings / poems for your venue ceremony Collate a 'must have' photo list for your Choose your ceremony and reception music
